A Note from Pastor

Dear Congregation:

We inserted a gospel tract in each of the bulletins today to emphasize using them as a means of sharing the Lord with others.

Knowing that Pastor Busby was saved by reading a tract, I asked him to write out the story of how that happened:

"In August, 1979, (I was 16 years old), I received a phone call from a good friend of mine, Steve Forquer. Steve and I had grown up together, however, my family had recently moved so we did not see each other as much. Unbeknown to me, Steve and his family had all received Christ as their Savior. When Steve called, he invited me to play basketball.

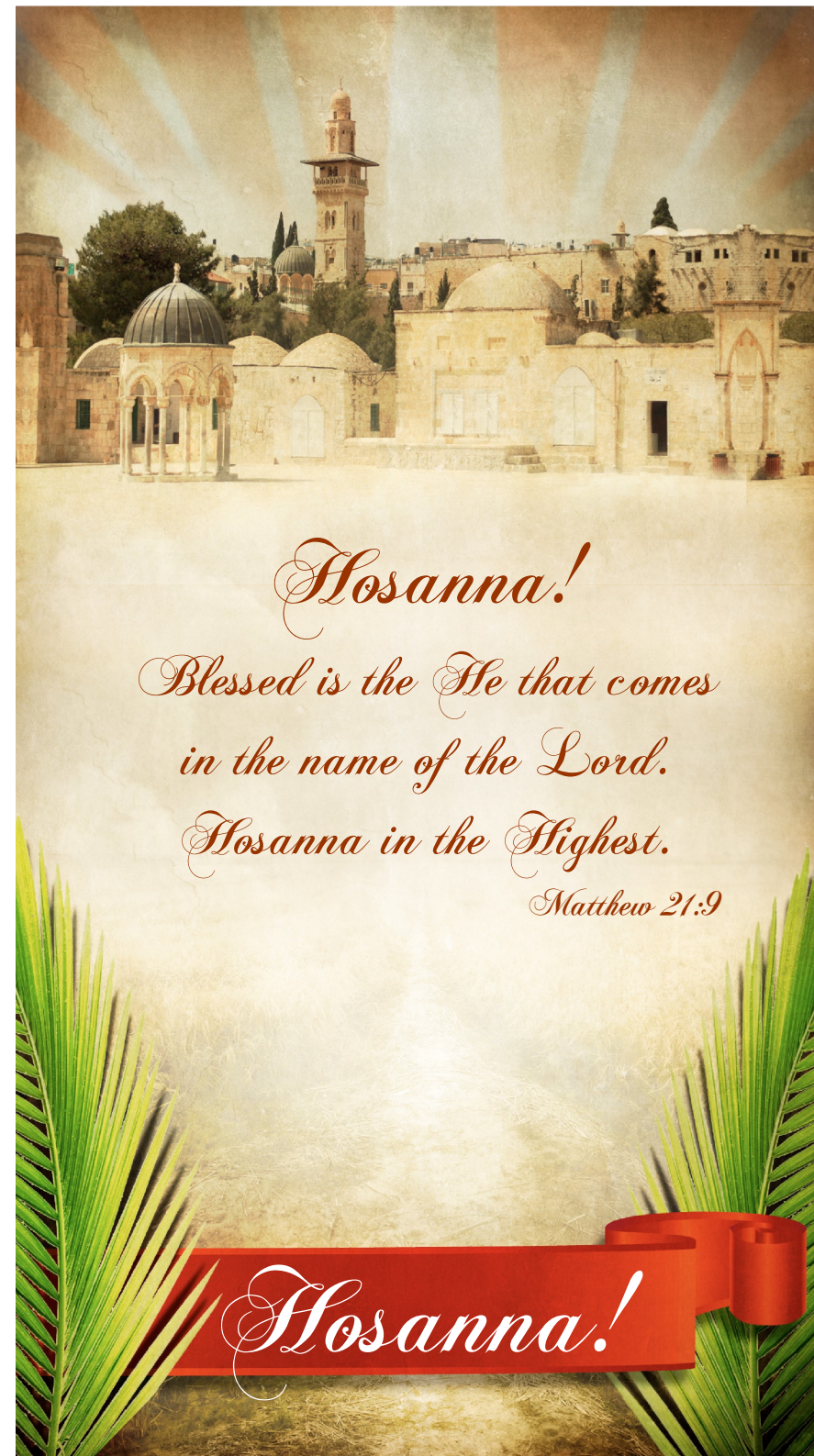
"I drove over to Steve's house to pick him up. He was still sleeping, but his father greeted me with a question: "Jerry are you saved?" I replied, "Saved from what?" He said, "Here read this," as he handed me a gospel tract entitled *What Must I Do to Be Saved*, by evangelist John R. Rice. The tract was based on the conversion of the Philippian jailor in Acts 16:25-34.

"That night after coming home from playing basketball all day, I took that tract out of my back pocket, and read it a couple of times. Then I found an old copy of the scriptures hidden in our bookshelves at home, and looked up the passage in the Bible. I remember being fascinated by that account. I must have read that tract at least 20 times. At that point, I realized I was a sinner in need of a Savior. So, at the side of my bed, I knelt down and prayed (I think for the first time in my life). I simply followed the prayer that was written on the back of the tract. I remember getting up and thinking that I wasn't any different. I went to the living room and told my mother what I had done. She just nodded as she worked on a crossword puzzle.

"Knowing that what I had done was significant, I then wrote to the address on the back of the tract. They sent me literature on spiritual growth. I began to go to church with Steve and his family - and the rest is history.

"A little side note: Pastor Lancaster had the opportunity to meet Dr. Rice's daughter, Jessie R. Sandberg, and he told her about my testimony. In the letter she wrote back to me, she said of her father, "Sometimes we grieve when the ministry of someone we love seems to be ended with his death, but you have reminded us that 'he, being dead, yet speaketh'."
