A NOTE FROM PASTOR

Dear Congregation:

A few weeks ago as I was driving around town, I heard a radio news announcer report the death of former baseball slugger and Hall of Famer Harmon Killebrew. I do not know much about Killebrew's spiritual life, but I immediately recalled a thought-provoking vignette about him that has always stuck with me. He would tell about a conversation from his childhood. "My father used to play with my brother and me in the yard, he said. Mother would come out and say, 'You're tearing up the grass!' 'We're not raising grass,' Dad would reply, 'We're raising boys'."

As those of us know, whose kids are now grown and gone from home, there is plenty of time to grow grass. It's the time we have to play with our children that is in short supply.

Fortunately for Joy and me, we are getting a second shot at "play time". Just recently I was struck with an awareness of the number of times I hear my grandchildren say, "Grampy, will you play with me?" Echoes of years past when I would hear the same frequent request from our three daughters. I try to always say "yes", even if I play for only a few minutes before I must go to a scheduled appointment.

Playing with our children, and grandchildren, is one of the ways we enhance their self-esteem. It says to them, "You are important to me, I like you and want to be with you." It also builds a relationship out of which respect grows. Times of discipline or intimate talk both flow much more naturally after playing together, because our kids know we really do love them and care about them. If we don't play frequently with them, their responses to us come tougher when we ask them to "obey their parents in the Lord" (Ephesians 6:1).

But it takes time, dad. We must be intentional about it. We have to turn off the TV, or computer, and show them how valuable they are by playing games or tossing ball with them in the yard. Someday when the grass is full and green, you'll wish you had.
