LIBRARY CORNER

Have you ever wondered about the reward you will receive at the Judgement Seat of Christ? *All About Crowns*, by Dr. W.A. Smith is a great book about the different crowns in heaven, what they mean, and why they are given.

Dear Congregation:

Over the years of my pulpit ministry I have kept a primary focus upon the person and work of Jesus Christ. As Paul expressed it in First Corinthians 2:1,2, "And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God. For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and Him crucified."

In so doing, I have preached expositively through Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. I also have preached lengthy series on the Olivet Discourse, the Sermon on the Mount, the Parables of Christ, and His crucifixion. Most recently we have been studying the resurrection in the series *Interviews at the Empty Tomb*.

Next Sunday is a new series. The introductory message is entitled, "When the Light of the World Confronts the Darkness." The sermons will give consideration to the religious conditions of the people of Israel at the time Christ arrived on earth. It seeks to answer questions such as: How did he address the culture of that day? In what ways did he confront the darkness of that time?

The study will require us to take a careful look at the context of his ministry. As Paul Benware summarizes it in his book, *Survey of the New Testament*, "Just as there are a great many religious systems and ideas in modern society, so there were in the days of the Roman Empire. Christ, the apostles, and the early church confronted a wide range of religions and philosophies. A brief word about these is needed in order to sense something of the spiritual context that the Lord Jesus and the apostles lived and ministered in."
