Where is Olivos, Argentina?

Olivos is the wealthiest part of the city of Buenos Aires. It's suburbs are where most of the affluent live.



What will we be doing while in Argentina?

Our primary purpose is to build the main sanctuary which we will work on during the day. In the evenings we will have outreach services to share our faith in parks and schools, using silent drama presentations.

Who can go and how many?

In order to be accepted on this trip, you will have to be at least 16 years old, in faithful attendance at SRBC, and apply by using the registration forms located in the Information Center. There is also a reference form that needs to be completed, they are in the same area. Ideally, the team will be composed of several teens, college students, and adults, totaling, 20 - 40 people. Once all your information is turned in, a select group composed of pastors and church leaders will select the team.
