Library Corner

Who Are You to Judge, by Dr. Edwin Lutzer, is a book about discernment: the ability to distinguish the false from the half true. As believers, we should judge biblical Christianity from counterfeit spirituality and values of today's world.

Dear Congregation:

We just received word this past week of the homegoing of one of our "family members." The sudden news of his death on Christmas Eve was an emotional blow to us, especially our daughters. Bill Hensler, a former SRBC member, who for some years has lived near his daughter Darlene Judy in Plano, Texas, has entered the presence of the Lord.

You see, Bill and his wife Betty (who preceded him in death years ago) were the closest thing to being grandparents to our kids without actually being their grandparents. Without any formal fanfare, they "adopted" our children when they were little. They never ever tried to take the place of the grandparents and were never presumptuous about the relationship. They were just there, loved and laughed with our kids, and made them feel special (like taking them out for ice cream "in their car with the fancy interior and car seat warmers", as our kids would put it.) I think Bill and Betty knew that sometimes preachers' kids can develop a complex because they feel they are not allowed to be "normal."

Our girls loved to go to "the base" with the Henslers. Bill was a Naval officer and as they entered the gate at MacDill AFB in Tampa, the guards were required to give one of those majestic military salutes. It made our girls feel like they were riding with royalty.

I do not think we can overestimate the meaningful role grandparents can have in the lives of their grandchildren. The unconditional love expressed, the time taken, and the patience shown has a powerful and lasting influence.

Last Sunday after church, Joy and I went up the street to Panera Bread to eat. As we walked by one of the tables, church members Tony and Carolyn Shoemaker were eating with their granddaughter, Savannah, who is in first grade. Savannah had her AWANA Sparks book open and they were helping her learn her sections, which includes memorizing Bible verses. As I walked away I could not help but think of the precious and rewarding bond that is being built by that relationship.

Sometimes the smallest things we do as grandparents or "make-believe grandparents", as Bill Hensler referred to himself, can have a lasting impression.

We'll miss you, Bill, but see you at the family reunion in heaven.
