In his book, *Lord, Change My Attitude*, James MacDonald says that attitudes are patterns of thinking that take years to form. This book is intended to bring about radical, positive change to your life if you let it.

Dear Congregation:

We have special guests with us today to minister in word and song.

Our speaker this morning is Dr. Charles Ware, president of Crossroads Bible College in Indianapolis, Indiana. The college is a biblically conservative evangelical institution dedicated to training Christian leaders to reach the multi-ethnic urban world for Christ.

Dr. Ware and I serve together on the Board Development Committee of the Association of Baptists for World Evangelism. Our committee meets here tomorrow and Tuesday.

In addition to leading the college, this past June 17, he and former Indianapolis Colts (and Tampa Bay Bucs) coach Tony Dungy teamed up together to launch the "Rebuild America Campaign". Its purpose, according to a question and answer article in the Indianapolis Star newspaper, is "to sound the alarm that Americans must return to their Christian roots before it is too late. Like Rome, or any past world power that reaches its apex and then begins to decline because its people no longer are bonded by and grounded in truth, America is sliding into an economic, intellectual, moral, and spiritual abyss. The decline will continue in every area unless we do something about it."

Our guest musicians today are Ron and Gary Matthews, one of the most gifted and dynamic duet teams in our country. As duo vocalists, pianists, organists, and trumpeters, they bring a rich spirit of worship to every concert.

Beyond their many academic achievements in music and their abilities as composers, they are most grateful for God's amazing love. As they put it, "It is this love that made them aware of God very early in their lives. It is this love that provided wonderful parents who demonstrated the love of God in a stable marriage and a happy home. It is this love that led Ron and Gary in the selection of their gracious and godly spouses. It is this love that has blessed Ron and Gary with children who love to sing and play. It is this love that has tenderly confronted Ron and Gary with the need to worship, grow in faith and responsibility, and to trust amid pain and questioning. It is this love that caused the invisible God to reveal Himself and offer his eternal Son, Jesus Christ, as a substitute for our sin, unbelief, and rebellion. It is Amazing Love!"
