Our guest concert artist this evening is baritone soloist Burt Kettinger. It will be my first opportunity to meet him personally, though we have talked by phone.

Several months ago, after the article about our granddaughter, Katie, who has Down syndrome, appeared in the *Shepherds Folder* periodical, I received a call from Burt. He shared with me how much the article meant to him, especially since he and his wife, Sharon, have a son with Down syndrome. He was such an encouragement, and he told me that his son, B.J., is "a happy young man who brings smiles to everyone he meets." Our little Katie does the same.

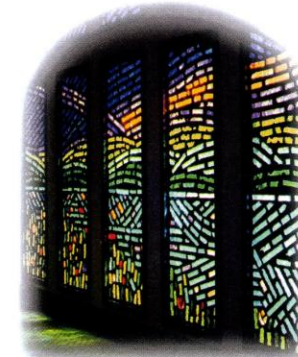
Burt has been travelling full-time since June, 1974, (ironically, that's the same month and year I began my ministry at this church). Much of his work in earlier years was in affiliation with The Moody Bible Institute in Chicago. Burt was the solo voice on Moody Presents from 1974 – 1987, and can now be heard each Sunday evening as one of the soloists on Songs in the Night from historic Moody Memorial Church. Thanks to Moody Radio, as well as many other radio networks, his musical ministry has traveled much farther than he has personally gone.

Burt holds a master's degree in voice from the American Conservatory of Music in Chicago, and is also an ordained minister with the Evangelical Free Church in America. As such, he does a good deal of preaching in addition to his singing as he journeys wherever the Lord opens a door for ministry.

His presentations are, as he states it, "to give people insight into the Word of God. Thus, I love to sing songs that either have a biblical text, or are at least based in the Scriptures."
