Dear Congregation:

This past Sunday during the “fireside chat” in the evening service, I shared with the congregation the next step toward filling the Student Ministries position on our pastoral team. As you may remember, when Pastor Dean completed his service with us on March 1, 2009, I stepped into that position temporarily. We began to pray and seek the Lord’s will as to who would be our next Student Ministries Pastor.

On May 17, 2009, Todd (and Julie) Broaderick began a one-year pastoral internship with us. Todd and Julie had given their lives for career ministry on November 25, 2007. Todd, who is a graduate in Business Administration from the University of Nebraska, began working on a Masters in Christian Studies from Luther Rice Seminary (Lithonia, Georgia) on January 18, 2008. He is scheduled to graduate on Friday, May 14, 2010.

Other than their seminary course studies, each of our interns have special assignments to do during the year. Since we were without a Student Ministries Pastor, we gave Todd the assignment to assist me in leading the middle school, high school, and college students. Todd loved the responsibilities and quickly connected with the youth leadership team, the teens, and the college students. Though I did talk with potential candidates for the student ministries position outside the church, Todd’s interest and passion for the students became more and more evident.

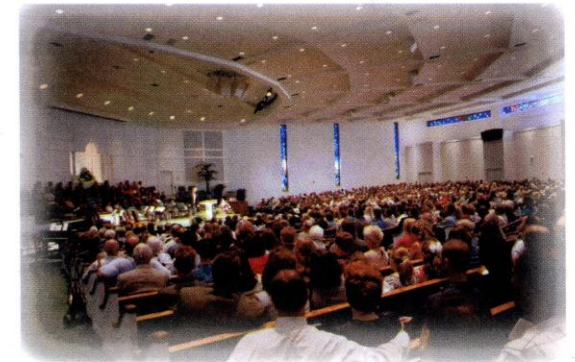
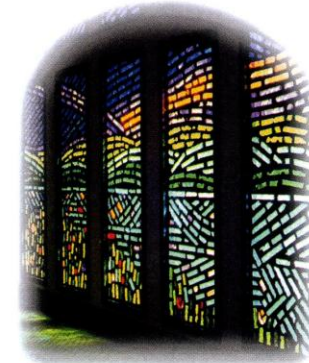
