It's kinda fun reminiscing about my high school friends as I study the pictures. Since the play takes place in Scotland, there I am in my plaid kilt (laugh!). It also makes me smile as I think of how much I enjoyed having my hair sprayed silver to act the role of the father (No, I have not continued the practice through the years!).

Interesting that Kathleen (Glab), whose beautiful voice and flair for drama earned her the lead role, is the one who would become Joy's college roommate later that year. She is the one God used to introduce me to Joy. She remains a dear friend to this day. Because of Kathleen's special relationship to us, we named our youngest daughter Erika KATHLEEN after her.
